

**Failure to Submit a
Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP),
MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The CITY OF KERENS water system PWS ID 1750005 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by TCEQ in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations through the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period second quarter of 2016.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

1. Be more diligent in mailing the reports on a timely basis.
2. Mail all future reports to the TCEQ by certified mail with a return receipt requested.

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses.). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
